

- 1. LED Light
- 2. Focus control
- 3. Tail button



#### **C.** Batteries

FULLY CHARGE RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES BEFORE FIRST USE. Initial battery charge may take up to 5 hours. CHARGING THE RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES

• Remove battery sleeve and all battery packaging

• Place the batteries into the charger, and insert the charger into an electrical outlet

• Batteries are fully charged when the light on the charger changes from RED to GREEN, approximately 5 hours

To use the flashlight kit with the best performance, use only MSFORCE batteries. Use only 18650 3.7v lithium-ion batteries. **Prior to first use fully charge the batteries.**

#### **D. Model 390A Batteries**

- Remove the end cap of the flashlight by turning it counterclockwise
- Insert 2 Charged Rechargeable batteries into the flashlight
- Replace the end cap of the flashlight and turn clockwise until tightened



## E. Model 310A Battery

Rechargeable battery:

- Remove the end cap of the flashlight by turning it counterclockwise.
- Insert 1 Charged Rechargeable battery with the protection sleeve into the flashlight.
- Replace the end cap of the flashlight and turn clockwise until tightened.




## F. Light Modes

- \* Full click to turn on, full click to turn off
- \* Half click to switch beween modes
- High
- •• Medium
- ••• Low
- •••• Strobe
- •••• SOS



## G. Focus System

- Retract the flashlight head for an adjustable diffused light beam
- Extend the flashlight head for an adjustable focused light beam



#### H.WARNING

TO AVOID RISK OF INJURY, DO NOT EXPOSE BATTERIES TO EXCESSIVE HEAT.


To reduce the risk of personal injury or harm to your headlamp, take the following precautions:

Use only 18650 lithium batteries from a reputable manufacturer. Do not use different brands of batteries in the same headlamp When replacing batteries, always replace the whole set. Do not try to recharge batteries that are not specifically designed to be recharged.

Warning: batteries must be inserted correctly. Failure to do so could cause permanent damage to the LED module.

Follow the battery manufacturer's instructions as to proper handling, storage and disposal of batteries.

Carefully follow the steps listed under INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE.
